

CITY OF BRADENTON BEACH DIRECTIVE: #6**

Effective April 9, 2020

The State of Florida, Manatee County and the City of Bradenton Beach have all declared a State of Emergency due to COVID-19. During the pendency of this State of Emergency, law enforcement shall strictly enforce illegally parked vehicles and, when a vehicle poses a threat to the public health, safety and welfare, the officer shall be vested with the authority to have the vehicle removed by a licensed towing service company at the expense of the owner.

On or about March 20, 2020, Manatee County Island Beaches were closed until further notice by Manatee County. Cortez and Coquina Beach parking areas have been barricaded on both the Gulf of Mexico and Sarasota Bay sides of Gulf Drive. Any disturbance to the barricade or breach thereto shall be punishable by federal, state and/or local law, and the vehicle may be towed at the expense of the owner.
