#### CITY OF BRADENTON BEACH DIRECTIVE: #7

**Effective May 15, 2020**

On or about March 17, 2020, the City of Bradenton Beach declared a State of Local Emergency related to the Coronavirus Disease 2019. Accordingly, the City has supported and recommended the practice of social distancing per Governor DeSantis in Executive Order #20-83 and the Florida Department of Health Office of the Surgeon General. Pursuant to Executive Order 20-91, Article II of the City Charter, and Ordinance 07-399, this is a directive to safeguard the citizenry from large social gatherings.

During the pendency of this State of Emergency, law enforcement shall strictly enforce illegally parked vehicles and, when a vehicle poses a threat to the public health, safety and welfare, the officer shall be vested with the authority to have the vehicle removed by a licensed towing service company at the expense of the owner.
